Directions: Travel on I-90 north to I-43/Hwy. 81 exits . Exit at Hwy. 81 Beloit, Exit 185 (2nd exit.) Head west on Hwy 81/Milwaukee Rd. and travel 1½ miles. Leeson Park is on the left. Turn left as soon as you enter the park to get to the Leeson Pavilion. After the meal, we will follow Hwy. 81 towards downtown Beloit. It intersects Hwy. 51/Pleasant Street just north of the National Office. Turn left on Hwy. 51/Pleasant St. Watch for Swiss cow and bull painted on end of white building on right. There is ample parking space available adjacent to the office (south side).
